On February 8th, 2013 everything changed for this beautiful family. Jesse went to work as a Sherburne County Correctional Officer and was brutally attacked by inmates. He suffered a severe concussion, resulting in symptoms of Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, light and sound sensitivities, migraine headaches, and a brain injury. Due to these injuries, he is unable to work or drive and has multiple medical appointments per week. At this point, Jesse has to let his brain heal, which can take years.
