Wrestling scheduled to start approximately 30-min after session start time. Please arrive on time and ready to wrestle.

Registration/Event details

- Wrestlers will wrestle on full mats with certified officials
- 8 person Double Elimination Championship Bracket run on Trackwrestling
- Awards 1-5 Place - Wall Chart/Bout Sheet for Champions
- Outstanding Wrestler award for each session (most falls in least amount of time)
- 1 minute period for grades 1-2; 1:30 period for grades 3-4 and 5-6 (first period consolation rounds 1:00)
- Pre-register only on Trackwrestling.com No day of on-site registration permitted.

- Pre-Registration closes Thursday, April 8th at 11:59pm. No refunds if you do not compete at the tournament for any reason.
- Grades will be combined within a session for brackets
- Registration is \$30.00 and covers wrestler plus one spectator admission both must be preregistered on Trackwrestling.
- Trackcast will be available.
- Only the wrestler and one spectator are allowed entrance during the designated session time. If parents have children wrestling in other sessions those wrestlers will not be admitted entrance until their designated session time begins.
- Club coaches will not be permitted entrance unless registered as a plus one for a wrestler

### Weigh-ins/Skin Check

- No on-site weigh in. Honor system during pre-registering on Trackwrestling
- Random weight audits will be conducted and wrestlers must be within 3% of their registered weight. If a wrestler fails a weigh audit you may be removed from the tournament
- Parents, please make sure to register the weight your wrestler will be at for his or her session. Choose the higher weight to alleviate any issues.
- Skin Checks will be conducted when the session opens

### Venue details

- No athlete or spectator/coach should be present with signs or symptoms of COVID-19 within the last 14 days
- Anyone with a documented case of COVID-19 must be cleared by his or her physician to participate in competition
- Social distancing is encouraged and masks are to be worn at all times following Paynesville Area Schools Face covering requirements, below
- Wrestlers do not have to wear masks during competition but should be masked at all other times
- Upon receiving awards, we ask you to promptly exit the building
- Some concessions will be available

Paynesville Area Schools Face covering requirements All individuals at the tournament will be required to wear a face covering, except for individuals warming-up prior to the competition and those actually competing will not need a mask while they participate in the physical activity of this sport, but as soon as they are done warming-up or their match is over a face covering is required to be put on.
