TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION

Pre-Registration will be done on-line. Registration will remain open until the tournament. www.grandrapidsmnwrestling.com.

There will be no refunds if you do not compete at the tournament for any reason.

Tournament Pre-Registration fee: **\$40.00. This will include the wrestler and their plus 2 spectators.**

Admissions will not be taken at the door. If you have a child wrestling in another session they will not be let in until their assigned session.

ON YOUR HONOR WEIGH INS

When registering you will be asked to enter your wrestlers' weight they will be when they wrestle at the tournament. We will be doing your honor weigh-ins at the tournament. Weight audits may be conducted and must be within 3% of registered weight. If failure to make weight you may be removed from the tournament. (Parents please make sure you register for the weight your wrestler will be at his or her session time, choose the higher weight to alleviate any issues.). Skin and Nail checks will be conducted after sign-in.

Venue details -

- No athlete, spectator, or coach should be present with signs or symptoms of COVID-19 within the last 14 days Anyone with a documented case of COVID-19 must be cleared by his or her physician to participate in competition
- Social distancing is encouraged and masks are to be worn at all times.
- Wrestlers do not have to wear masks during competition but should be masked at all other times
- Awards will be given to wrestlers but no podium will be available.
- Limited concessions will be provided, including water, soda and Gatorade. Prepackaged snacks may be available as well.
- When eating and unmasked, participants/spectators must be distanced 6 feet from each other and not sitting in groups.
